

BETTY CANTLAY MEMORIAL

100 YARDS HANDICAP

Betty Cantlay was Victorian Shot Put Champion and Australian record holder at the time of her death in 1952.

Betty was returning from a church service in June 1952 when the bus on which they were travelling was struck by a train at Boronia. Betty passed away some hours later without regaining consciousness.

Her passing was a great loss to the club. She was an outstanding club member; her strict adherence to the principles of amateur athletics set a very fine example to her fellow competitors whom she was always willing to assist, both on and off the sports ground. Club President, Doris Davis, who was also President of the Victorian Womens Amateur Athletic Association, donated the shield to perpetuate Betty's memory.
